WINTER BEACH BECOMES A DESTINATION POINT

If you are a kayak or canoe enthusiast you will be happy to know that the Indian River Land Trust has purchased conservation property at the east end of Quay Dock Road. This historic wagon road built in the 1890s was used by early settlers on John’s Island and the peninsula to transport their produce from the Quay Dock to Quay Station, now Winter Beach. The property contains mangrove swamps but does include a small landing ideal for a launch pad. The launch is expected to be open to members and guests in late 2011. IRLT is a non-profit organization celebrating 20 years of conserving important land and water resources in Indian River County. Membership dues are \$35.
